

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Average Annual Percentage Increase in Inflation-Adjusted Published Prices by Decade, 1984-85 to 2014-15










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
Published and Net Prices in 2014 Dollars, Full-Time In-District Undergraduate Students at Public Two-Year Institutions, 1994-95 to 2014-15

Published and Net Prices in 2011-12 by Family Income: Full-Time Dependent Students at Private Nonprofit Four-Year Institutions






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Distribution of Federal Subsidized and Unsubsidized Student Loan Funds by Sector, 2004-05 to 2013-14



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Total Federal and Nonfederal Loans in 2013 Dollars, 1993-94 to 2013-14




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

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




State Grant Aid per Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Undergraduate Student by State, 2012-13
