

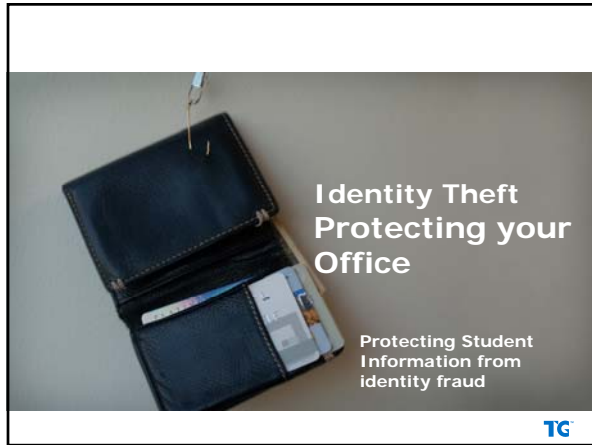

- Security Conscious Office

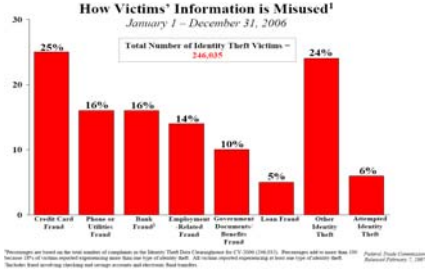

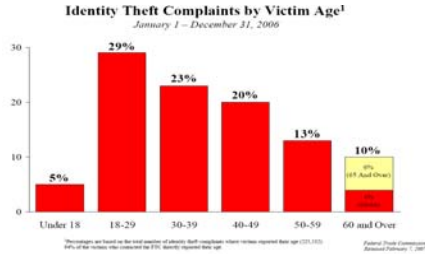
