

SASF^{AA} Responds to Fed.Up!

At the request of the SASF^{AA} Executive Board, the 2001-2002 Legislative Relations Committee provided suggestions to Representative Buck McKeon and Patsy Mink's FED.UP regulatory relief initiative.

A list of over 70 possible statutory and regulatory changes were developed and the executive board selected thirteen issues for SASF^{AA}'s response that appear to be of greatest concern to the financial aid community.

These recommendations ([WORD](#) and/or [PDF](#)) were posted to the [Fed.Up website](#) on July 19, 2001.

Although the July 20 deadline has passed, Rep. McKeon has indicated that they will continue to leave the site up for a while and will consider additional suggestions.

If you have not yet responded to this initiative, we urge you to do so as soon as possible. It isn't often that the financial aid community is asked for its suggestions for improvement and regulatory relief. Now that we have been asked it is important that we take advantage of this opportunity. Who knows when/if we will have another chance?
