- Have five (5) years or less financial aid experience;
- Submit an original statement with this application. The statement should be at least one typed page but no more than two pages in length on the following topic: ***Discuss the value and importance of student aid and how it relates to your choosing the Financial Aid profession.***
- Submit a current resume'; **and**
- A letter of recommendation from the Financial Aid Director at your institution.

Please have your application submitted by **April 15, 2022**.
